As well as our work **fighting to prevent diabetes and its complications**, we are working in Senegal to increase education opportunities for those with disabilities, as well as our work increasing sexual and reproductive health rights of girls and women. This is in addition to physical and functional rehabilitation projects. Our mine action team are demining and carrying out risk education activities in various locations in Senegal. They conduct clearance operations to release land back to the communities and improve access to services.

Senegal, like many African countries, is bearing an increasingly **heavy diabetes burden**. Improvement in prevention, care, and treatment, has been desperately needed. To date, resources in Senegal were insufficient and there had been a lack of infrastructure and equipment for appropriate care of diabetes and its complications. “**Tother Against Diabetes**”, for which **Festival Medical Services** are kindly supporting, really goes a long way in addressing these issues at every level.
